

Additional Preparations for the Wedding

The following are some guidelines to assist you in preparing for your wedding at St. George:

Rehearsal: Normally, the rehearsal for the wedding is held on the Friday before the wedding date. Everyone in the bridal party should attend, including the parents and ushers. The rehearsal usually lasts about an hour. Please ask your bridal party to be prompt in arriving.

Music: Typically, there are two musical expressions at the wedding: Music for the prelude, processional, and recessional, and chanting during the wedding. The Priest can provide you with suggestions upon request, as well as making arrangements for a chanter for your wedding.

Flowers: Floral arrangements should be in keeping with church décor. Care is asked to not deface Church property. Arrangements can be put in the candle holders if care is taken that they aren't in the way of the candles. We ask that flower girls do not scatter real flower petals unless an aisle runner is used.

Dressing Rooms: We do not have an official dressing room here at the Church although there are rooms that could be used for this purpose.

Photography: In order to preserve appropriate decorum, we ask that no artificial lights (flashbulbs or floodlights) be used during the ceremony. Photographers should also take care to remain inconspicuous so as not to disrupt the service. Photographs and video recordings may be taken from the back of the nave and/or the side aisles.

Food and Drink: No food or drink is allowed in the Church, including the Narthex.
