Saint George Home School Community Learning Center is pleased to facilitate another year of Classical- and Charlotte Mason-inspired learning! Our mission is to provide affordable and specialized tutoring services in a nurturing Orthodox Christian environment. We serve homeschooling families with children ages 4-16, who participate in small mixed-age learning groups. Children are given the opportunity to progress at their own pace, while tutors work with the strengths of each child on an individual basis and help identify areas of need. We recognize parents as the primary educators of their children, with the Learning Center as a partner in this endeavor. Our focus is on a "living" education and the formation of the individual person through relationship and exposure to what is good, beautiful, and true. In addition, homeschooling families benefit from the balance and reinforcement that the Learning Center provides to their educational time in the home.





Location and Schedule

The Learning Center is housed at St. George Greek Orthodox Church in Eugene. Our Full-Day Program takes place on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:45am-1:45 pm. The Enrichment Program classes have a separate schedule which is still being determined for Fall Term.

Curriculum and Approach

Our approach to learning is inspired by the work of Charlotte Mason, a 19th century British educator, as well as classical education. Central to both philosophies is the truth that a child is a person created in the image of God, and therefore capable of becoming Christ-like and deserving of a nurturing education that will allow this to take place. An education like this emphasizes the great and beautiful works of literature, history, art, and science, as well as the rhythms of the natural world and the liturgical cycles of the Orthodox Church.

Our core curriculum is *A Gentle Feast*, a Charlotte Mason program for all ages which integrates the subjects of history, literature, science, art, and geography through different historical periods. We supplement this program as needed with other literature-based curricula. Our Pre-K/Kindergarten program also utilizes Montessori-inspired methods and materials.

As students reach middle-school age, our program begins to incorporate elements of classical logic and rhetoric, emphasizing the development of the students' abilities to think and communicate critically, clearly, and effectively. Above all, our desire is to foster the growth of wisdom, a lifelong love of learning, and thoughtful engagement with the world.
